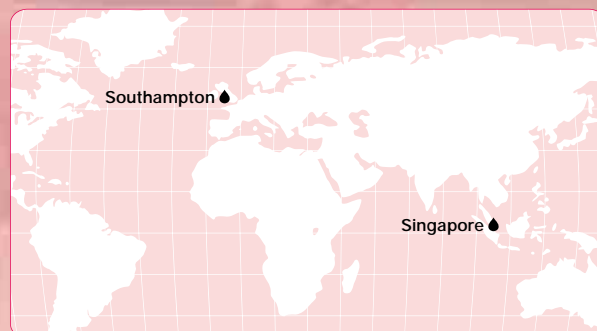

Assessment Option – Conducted under *Oil Spill Response's* OPITO Approved Competence Management System (ACMS)

Delegates who take the Assessment Option and pass will be awarded a certificate of competence against *Oil Spill Response's* occupational standard for On-Scene Commanders. The delegate will be assessed throughout the course and tasked with building a portfolio containing evidence of competence. Candidates who pass the assessment will be awarded a certificate of competence recognised by OPITO. The OPITO Assessment Option requires payment of a further 25% of the stated course fees.
